Mr. Art Levine has made significant contributions to exposing a wide range of corporate and governmental corruption within the mental health industry. He is a prize-winning investigative journalist and contributing editor of the *Washington Monthly*, and has written for the *American Prospect*, *Salon*, *The Atlantic*, *The Daily*, *The Beast*, *Mother Jones*, *Truthout*, *AlterNet*, and numerous other publications. His recent book, *Mental Health Inc: How Corruption, Lax Oversight and Failed Reforms Endanger Our Most Vulnerable Citizens* calls for a rejection of the coercive medical model and argues for a more individualized and humane approach. In it, he devoted a full chapter to highlighting ISEPP's interest in treating veterans and military members with humanity instead of medicine. His work has been a boon to our efforts at increasing public awareness of the dangers of the orthodox system. Mr. Levine's keen interest in and sacrifices for the suffering of others makes him more than worthy of receiving this year's Mary Karon Memorial Award for Humanitarian Concerns.
